DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

DAY 1: VANCOUVER SIGHTSEEING

- **Transportation:** Transfer from Vancouver Cruise Terminal to hotel
- **Highlights:** Vancouver sightseeing tour
- **Meals:** On your own
- **Hotel:** Sheraton Vancouver Wall Center, Vancouver (4-star) or similar

Disembark at Canada Place Terminal and board a coach for a half-day sightseeing tour of the city. Pass by English Bay, Robson Street, Gastown, and Chinatown, with stops at Stanley Park to view its renowned totem poles and at Granville Island Public Market for independent exploration. After the tour, you'll be taken to your hotel. The evening is yours to enjoy at your leisure.

DAY 2: ROCKY MOUNTAINEER TRAIN (FROM VANCOUVER TO KAMLOOPS)

- **Transportation:** Transfer from hotel to Rocky Mountaineer station and from Kamloops station to hotel
- **Highlights:** Journey from Vancouver to Kamloops aboard Rocky Mountaineer with GoldLeaf Service**
- **Meals:** Breakfast and Lunch (on board Rocky Mountaineer)
- **Hotel:** Kamloops 3–3.5-star hotel (provided by Rocky Mountaineer)

Wake early and check out of the hotel before transferring to the train station. Board the Rocky Mountaineer and enjoy breakfast as you journey to Kamloops. Travel through the Fraser Valley, lush forests, and dramatic canyons, with views of the Coast and Cascade Mountains along the way. Savor lunch on board as the train transitions into the desert-like landscape surrounding Kamloops, following the shoreline of Kamloops Lake before arriving in the city. Upon arrival at approximately 7:00 pm (schedule subject to change), transfer by motor coach to your overnight accommodation. Hotels in Kamloops are moderate in standard, with room assignments managed by Rocky Mountaineer. Spend the evening at your leisure and enjoy dinner on your own; the train representative can provide local dining recommendations.

DAY 3: ROCKY MOUNTAINEER TRAIN (FROM KAMLOOPS TO BANFF)

- **Transportation:** Transfer from hotel to Kamloops station and from Banff station to hotel
- **Highlights:** Journey from Kamloops to Banff aboard Rocky Mountaineer with GoldLeaf Service**
- **Meals:** Breakfast and Lunch (on board Rocky Mountaineer)
- **Hotel:** Fairmont Banff Springs, Banff (4-star) or similar

An early morning transfer from the hotel to Kamloops station ensures you are on board Rocky Mountaineer by approximately 6:30 am. Enjoy breakfast as your journey continues toward the Canadian Rockies. Travel eastward from British Columbia into Alberta, taking in the spectacular landscapes along the way. Visit Craigellachie, a site of historical significance in Canadian rail history. Savor lunch on board as the train ascends Rogers Pass, traverses Kicking Horse Canyon, and passes through the remarkable Spiral Tunnels, with views of glaciers and the snow-capped peaks of the Canadian Rockies. The journey concludes in Banff in the evening, after 8:00 pm (times may vary). Upon arrival at the Banff station, transfer to the Fairmont Banff Springs hotel, situated in the heart of Banff National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Known as Canada's "Castle in the Rockies," this iconic landmark has welcomed guests since 1888. Check into the hotel, enjoy the facilities, and dine at your leisure.

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY *continued*

DAY 4: LAKE LOUISE FROM BANFF

- **Highlights:** Visit Lake Louise and Moraine Lake in Banff National Park
- **Meals:** Breakfast and Group Dinner
- **Hotel:** Fairmont Banff Springs, Banff (4-star) or similar

Today's itinerary includes a visit to Lake Louise, one of Banff National Park's most well-known destinations. After breakfast, begin your journey through the scenic Banff Valley, passing towering mountains, lush forests, and clear rivers. You'll also have the chance to view the Victoria Glacier from a distance. Upon arrival at Lake Louise, you'll have time to explore the area, take photos, and enjoy the striking turquoise waters. Next, continue to Lake Moraine, known for its vibrant blue color and picturesque setting. The lake sits against a backdrop of the Ten Peaks, offering impressive scenery. Afterward, return to your hotel in Banff and enjoy a group dinner this evening.

Please note: The road to Moraine Lake is operated seasonally. While the opening is scheduled for the beginning of June, it is highly weather-dependent. In the case of a road closure, the stop would be replaced by a visit of Emerald Lake.

DAY 5: BANFF SIGHTSEEING

- **Highlights:** Banff Familiarization Tour & Gondola
- **Meals:** Breakfast
- **Hotel:** Fairmont Banff Springs, Banff (4-star) or similar

After breakfast, enjoy a familiarization tour of Banff, including stops at Tunnel Mountain and Bow Falls, and time to explore the shops and restaurants of Banff Village. Later, take a ride on the Banff Gondola, ascending to 7,486 feet for expansive views of the Canadian Rockies. At the summit, enjoy 360-degree views of six mountain ranges and the Bow Valley from the observation deck. The remainder of the day is free to explore Banff at your leisure.

Please note: While the Gondola Ride and Summit area are wheelchair accessible, the upper boardwalk, which provides a loop around the mountain is not wheelchair accessible due to its steep incline and uneven terrain, there are plenty of other accessible viewing spots and facilities at the top where you can enjoy the scenery.

DAY 6: TRANSFER TO CALGARY AIRPORT

- **Transportation:** Transfer from Banff to Calgary Airport
- **Meals:** Breakfast

After breakfast at the hotel, check out and meet your driver at the appointed time, for your transfer to the Calgary International Airport (YYC).

We suggest you wear flat, non-slip walking shoes. This Land Tour is recommended to guests who are able to walk for extended periods, at a moderate pace. Guests who utilize a wheelchair may not be able to participate in all the activities described. If you require special assistance of any kind, please advise Azamara or your travel professional at the time of booking. Temperatures in Banff can be cool at times. Pack a jacket or warm outer layer just in case. Check-in at hotels is usually at 16:00 and check-out is usually at 11:00.


