DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1

Upon arrival at Johannesburg Airport, you'll transfer to Sandton and check into your hotel. Spend the remainder of your day relaxing at the hotel, enjoying a massage, or having a swim. From this luxurious base, you'll be around the corner from many designer fashion stores and excellent restaurants at the large Sandton City Shopping Centre. Rooms available from 2:00pm. Dinner is on your own this evening

Day 2

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before your transfer to Johannesburg airport for your flight to Eastgate Airport in Hoedspruit where, upon arrival you'll transfer to Kapama Private Game Reserve, located between the Blyde River Valley and Kruger National Park. Kapama is home to over 40 different species, including the Big Five: elephants, lions, leopards, buffalo, and rhinos. After checking in at River Lodge, enjoy high tea before heading out with your ranger for an afternoon game-drive. En route, stop for sundowner cocktails and watch the sun set over the distant peaks of the Drakensberg Mountains. As darkness falls, look out for the bush's nocturnal animals on the night drive back to the lodge, where dinner will be served this evening.

Day 3

Wake up to fantastic daybreak views of the African bush before embarking on an early morning game drive in an open 4x4 vehicle. Return to the lodge for a delicious breakfast and then spend the rest of the morning and afternoon at leisure, with a variety of options to entertain you. Later, embark on another game drive and, as the sun sets, look out to see the nocturnal animals that come out to hunt. Enjoy sundowners in the bush before returning to the lodge for a delicious dinner.

Day 4

This morning, enjoy a last, early-morning game drive before returning to the lodge for breakfast. Afterwards, check out and transfer to Hoedspruit Airport for your scheduled flight to Johannesburg where you'll check into your flight for Cape Town. Upon arrival in Cape Town you'll transfer to the winelands via a scenic drive through the picturesque town of Stellenbosch to your luxurious accommodations.

Day 5

After a leisurely breakfast, get ready to depart for a day that'll be sure to tantalize your taste buds. The Western Cape is blessed with the perfect climate for making world-class wines. And, to match the wine, it's also home to top-quality restaurants where outstanding food is usually served with an incredible view. Today is all about exploring these taste sensations, at the Vergelegen Estate, Morgenster Estate, and Anura Estate, punctuated with lunch at Tokara Restaurant where Chef Etienne Bonthuys produces innovative gourmet meals accompanied by the wonderful wines from the adjoining winery. Tonight, dinner will be enjoyed at your hotel.

Day 6

After a leisurely breakfast, check out and depart for Stellenbosch to explore the beautiful space filled with whitewashed homesteads, avenues of oaks, and rolling green hills. Start your walking exploration of the old town and discover Stellenbosch's colorful history while sampling local flavors through locally-produced artisanal food and drinks. Enjoy indigenous tea, traditional snacks—like biltong and droëwors—and fresh bread sticks from an artisan bakery. Your walking tour ends with lunch. After this interesting 'foodies walking' tour, transfer to Cape Town Harbour and embark your ship.

- This Land Journey involves an easy/moderate amount of walking that may be strenuous at times. You will be required to walk up/down inclines and stairs, over paved/unpaved, cobbled, and uneven ground & climb in and out of safari vehicles. We suggest you wear flat, non-slip walking shoes. This Land Journey is recommended to guests who are able to walk for extended periods, at a moderate pace.
- Guests who utilize a wheelchair may not be able to participate in all activities as described. Guest must climb into the safari vehicle at Kapama Private Game Reserve.
- A malaria prophylactic is recommended. Speak to your physician for what is best for you.
- If you require special assistance of any kind, please advise Azamara or your travel professional at the time of booking.
- What to wear: Safari clothing should be comfortable and casual. Wearing camouflage is prohibited.

Purchase your flights to Johannesburg through Azamara. If booking independently, ensure you have the correct city and arrival date prior to reserving your flights. Azamara is not responsible for any disruption to your Land Journey due to independently-booked air issues.

All programs have a limited capacity and are available on a first-come basis. A minimum number of guests is required to operate this Land Journey. Should that minimum not be met, the program will be repriced and guests will have the option to cancel or repurchase at the new selling price.
