Built in the 15th century, this mystical city was raised without using any mortar at all and includes great buildings that play with exacting astronomical alignment. A panoramic ride aboard the Hiram Bingham Train takes you to this archeological wonder for a one-day expedition that explores its many mysteries—the hallmark of a journey that reveals Incan culture, local craftsmanship, spectacular natural beauty, and a wealth of Peruvian history.

All Passport details should be confirmed at the time of booking. Sales of this program close 90 days prior: book early to avoid disappointment, as space is limited.

- Machu Picchu: Enjoy one day discovering the secrets, history, and spiritual energy of this ancient Incan city and architectural wonder.
- Buenos Aires: Enjoy a whirlwind tour through the Argentine capital, often called ‘The Paris of South America.’

- Local Connections: Visit the workshop of a traditional hat maker and meet a local weaver committed to preserving Peru’s ancestral textile traditions.
- Hiram Bingham Train: Board this famed railway for the ride of a lifetime that winds through the Andes Mountains to Machu Picchu.
- Foodie Experiences: Savor a delicious gourmet lunch and a grand gourmet dinner aboard the Hiram Bingham Train. Enjoy a teatime amid Machu Picchu at the famed Belmond Sanctuary Lodge Restaurant. A picnic lunch in peaceful Huaypo Lagoon surrounded by the majestic Andes mountains and surrealistic landscapes
- Cusco: Visit the San Pedro Market, the Sacsayhuaman Fortress, Qoricancha Temple, and the city’s historic Cusco Cathedral.

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1

Debarking the ship, you'll be shown to your Buenos Aires hotel. Check in before setting out to experience Argentina's capital city – often called 'The Paris of South America.' You'll explore glamorous neighborhoods and trendy streets; visit the city's famous cemetery; and enjoy close looks at signature landmarks, including the Pink House and Metropolitan Cathedral. Make a special stop in San Telmo, where Buenos Aires' first settlements existed and where the Porteño aristocracy's history still echoes. Enjoy a traditional Argentinian lunch at a local restaurant before returning to the hotel. Relax. or set back out on your own – the afternoon is all yours.

Day 2

At 03:00 hrs, head to the airport to catch your flight to Lima, Peru (a box breakfast will be requested) before connecting to the short flight to Cusco – the launch point for your Incan adventure. Upon arrival in Cusco, a city set more than 11,000 feet above sea level, you'll be transferred to Cusco, where you will enjoy a Gourmet Lunch at your hotel. Afternoon, at leisure. Dinner at MAP Café Restaurant.

Day 3

Your expedition begins with a visit to the Moray Ruins, an Incan agricultural site. This system of circular terraces winds 490 feet below the viewpoint and stands as a testament to Incan ingenuity. From here, you'll embrace Peruvian culture at the workshop of a local hat maker, who's crafted an incredible 600,000 hats by hand. Enjoy a picnic lunch beneath the Andes at picturesque Huaypo Lagoon before visiting the village of Chinchero. This small town is known for its vibrant textiles, and you'll visit the workshop of Nilda Callañaupa, who is committed to preserving the ancestral art. Return to your hotel for dinner and plenty of stories to share.

Day 4

Machu Picchu is a panoramic train ride away. First, however, you'll visit one of the last remaining Incan towns, Ollantaytambo, and its archeological complex that once welcomed royal delegations. Learn about the history of the site before boarding the famed Hiram Bingham Train. Relax on the rumbling ride across the Andes Mountains. Enjoy a delicious lunch on board before arriving at the town of Aguas Calientes. From here, set off on a private expedition to the ruins. Prepare to be astounded by the genius, fascinated by the mysteries, and awed by the natural setting in which the Incas chose to erect their great city. A bit later, re-board the Hiram Bingham Train for the ride back to Ollanta Station, complete with a gourmet dinner and open bar. Arrive to the station and transfer to Cusco's City for a well-earned night's sleep.

Please note: From January to March the Hiram Bingham Train will depart or arrive from/to Ollanta Station because the rainy season.

Day 5

A day to discover the Cusco's highlights. You'll visit the bustling San Pedro Market, a kaleidoscope of aromas, flavors, and Andean traditions. Spend some time rubbing elbows with the locals before continuing to the Fortress of Sacsayhuaman, a colossal structure of enormous stones fitted together with uncanny precision. You'll also visit the Qoricancha Temple, dedicated to the Sun God. It's said that during Incan times the interior walls were entirely covered in gold. Next, pay a visit to Cusco Cathedral, home to priceless paintings from the Cusco School of the 17th and 18th centuries. Afterwards, enjoy a typical lunch at Limo restaurant before catching your flight back to Lima.

Day 6

Awaken to breakfast at your Lima. Say farewell to new friends before heading to the airport to catch your outbound flight.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- This Azamazing Journey is considered strenuous & designed for participants in good physical condition. You will be required to walk over even and uneven paved surfaces, grassy hills, steps made of rocks that are uneven and big steps, walking up inclines and down hills. We suggest you wear flat, non-slip walking shoes. This Azamazing Journey is recommended to guests who are able to walk for extended periods, at a moderate pace
- Adjustment to altitude can make you out of breath, and can cause a headache, nausea, and lightheadedness in some guests.
- Not recommended to guests who suffer from altitude sickness, difficulty walking up/down hills and steps or knee problems, and those with heart and/or respiratory issues. Not recommended for guest using wheelchairs or walking sticks due to knee or hip injuries. Guests must consider their physical fitness level and medical history when determining whether this tour is appropriate.
- If you require special assistance of any kind, please advise Azamara® or your travel professional at the time of booking.
- What to wear: Recommend layers of clothing that you can easily change according to varying weather conditions. It rains between December and March, so we recommend bringing a waterproof jacket. We recommend wearing comfortable clothes and tennis or trekking shoes during the tours. Rubber-soled shoes are also recommended when visiting archaeological sites. Always carry a light jacket.
- Peru uses 220 volts nationwide. Most 4-5-star hotels provide 110-volt plug-ins.
- As Belmond Hiram Bingham allows only one carry-on bag on board its train, guests will receive a small bag overnight bag per guest should be packed for the visit to Machu Picchu.

- It is forbidden to shoot photos in airports, military bases, places surrounding electric transmission towers and police stations. Also, in Cusco it is forbidden to take photographs into Museums and Churches. No professional cameras and tripod are allowed into Archaeological Sites.
