Dynamic Barcelona is known for its architecture, from the magnificent medieval buildings to the Modernist movement, and arguably second only to the architecture is its culinary scene and the celebrated tradition of Catalan cooking with its simple, flavorful ingredients (seafood, jamón (cured ham), and market-fresh produce), is alive and well, as are the Basque-style tapas bars. Your stay here features a full day of sightseeing, designed to showcase Barcelona's greatest attractions, including Gaudi's Sagrada Familia and the breathtaking—almost magical—Parque Güell, which was declared a World Heritage Site in 1984. Your tour also takes you to the city's central market—a feast for all the senses. Those who've opted to stay a third night in Barna have an additional experience with a local wine expert, sampling wines and tapas at some local hotspots.

All Passport details should be confirmed at the time of booking. Sales of this program close 90 days prior: book early to avoid disappointment, as space is limited.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- La Sagrada Familia: The most notable sight in Barcelona is undoubtedly this cathedral designed by Antonio Gaudí. Construction on the still-unfinished temple—which can hold

13,000 worshipers—began in 1882 and continues today. The organic design, with tilting stone columns reminiscent of a tree canopy, is a marvel of the imagination.

- Parc Güell: This park, with its famous mosaic work, was designed by Antonio Gaudí. Developed as a residential community, the homes were never built, and the constructed common areas, pathways, and grounds became one of the most remarkable urban parks in the world.
- Museu Marítim: Barcelona was one of the world's leading seaports and in the original Gothic-era shipyards, you'll find impressive full-size ship replicas, models, maps, navigation instruments, and carved figureheads.
- Museu Picasso: This treasury of Picasso's art, most from his formative years, fills five converted medieval mansions. Over 3,500 pieces of art, including paintings, drawings, and ceramics are on display.
- Mercat de la Boqueria: This central market dates to 1,200 A.D. and is a bustling maze of stalls selling fruits and vegetables, meats, fish, breads, sweets, and prepared foods. Pause for tapas and a coffee or glass of wine as you wind your way through the aisles.
- La Rambla: This is one of the world's most famous walking streets, and a great place for people watching, grabbing a coffee or snack, or watching street performers.
- Ca L'Estevet: For old-school Catalan dining, come to this restaurant that's been serving Barcelona residents for over a century. Dishes include a variety of small plates, seafood, ham, and local sausage.
- La Manual Aspargatera: For quintessential Spanish footwear—espadrilles—this shop is lined with floor-to-ceiling cubbies filled with handmade casual shoes in a rainbow of colors.
- Altair Bookstore: Travel book lovers can browse among two floors of books, maps, guides, and journals at one of the largest shops of its kind in Europe.

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1

Upon arrival in Barcelona you'll be met and taken to your hotel. The remainder of your day is yours to do as you will. Refer to our list of city highlights for some suggestions.

Day 2

After breakfast, meet your guide for a full day of sightseeing. During your tour, you'll visit works by Antoni Gaudí, including the outside visit Sagrada Família and Parc Güell. Construction on the Sagrada Família began 1882, with completion expected in 2026. Meanwhile, Parque Güell, was built between 1900 and 1914 and was officially opened as a public park in 1926. In 1984, UNESCO declared the park a World Heritage Site under "The Works of Antoni Gaudí." After, continue for a visit to the central market, where you'll get to experience Barcelona like a true local, interacting with the second-and third-generation vendors. Enjoy local products tasting at the market, before heading back to your hotel. The remainder of the day is at your leisure.

Day 3

Enjoy the morning at your leisure before regrouping in the afternoon to take a walk with a local wine expert to sample several wines and tapas at some of the locals' favorite spots. The remainder of the day is yours to enjoy as you wish.

Day 4

Enjoy a leisurely morning with breakfast at the hotel. Explore independently or just relax. At the appointed time, you'll be escorted to the airport for your onward flight.
