France's wine capital is also the world's largest urban World Heritage Site, with more than half the city sealed within its UNESCO-listed bounds. "The very essence of elegance," concluded The Queen upon her last visit to the city, and many would agree, putting Bordeaux ahead of Lyon, Marseille—even Paris—as the French city to visit. Your stay here features an immersive wine experience at La Cité du Vin, followed by vineyard visits. You'll also have the additional experience of a guided tour through Saint-Émilion. Walk along the historic city walls, visiting unique artist galleries and studios, and indulge in a wine tasting at a grand cru estate. The day's exploration also takes you to Rue Sainte-Catherine, Bordeaux's main shopping street, and to dinner at a local Château.

**All Passport details should be confirmed at the time of booking. Sales of this program close 90 days prior: book early to avoid disappointment, as space is limited.**

### HIGHLIGHTS:

- Quais de Bordeaux: Set next to the broad Garonne River, this scenic spot is ideal for picnics, bicycling, jogging, or simply sitting on a bench and watching the world go by.
- Bordeaux Cathedral: This striking example of medieval gothic design was the site where Eleanor of Aquitaine and the future Louis VII wed.
- Jardin Public: Inaugurated in 1746, the park is in the English style with expansive lawns, historic trees, statues, fountains and wrought iron bridges crossing its serpentine pond.
- La Cite du Vin: A 10-story, multimedia experience that explores every imaginable facet of wine. And, of course, the experience is made complete with a tasting of the region's most popular export.
- Rue Sainte-Catherine: The longest pedestrian shopping street in Europe hums with activity at all hours, with plenty of cafes in which to give your legs (and wallet) a break.

- Librairie Michele Masson: A rare book shop filled with beautifully aged tomes. Don't worry if you can't speak a lick of French, these books tell a tale that's all their own.
- Mieux: A one-stop shop for chic handbags, clothes, French papery, and trinkets.
- Apache: The workshop of Bordeaux jewelry designer Charlotte Guillard.
- La Brasserie Bordelaise: Located on Rue Saint-Rémi, one of the busiest streets in Bordeaux, La Brasserie Bordelaise is a gem that even locals vie their way for a reservation.
- Le Bistrot du Gabriel: Inside, this restaurant has a gourmet dining room, but the bustling bistro is outside, splendidly set right on the Place de la Bourse across from the River Garonne.

## DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

### Day 1

Upon arrival in Bordeaux you'll be met and taken to your hotel. The remainder of your day is yours to do as you will. Refer to our list of city highlights for some suggestions.

### Day 2

After breakfast, head to La Cité du Vin, for an immersive experience with your local expert. Situated in Bordeaux, La Cité du Vin is a new generation museum where wine comes to life through an immersive, sensorial approach, all set within an evocative architectural design. La Cité du Vin gives a fresh perspective and offers an eye-opening journey of wine—around the world, through the ages, and across cultures and civilizations. After, head to a local winery, for a delicious lunch with specially selected wine pairings before continuing on to Château Pape Clément, for a wine-making class with the cellar masters, followed by a winery and barrel cellar visit accompanied by wine tastings of the Château's finest vintages. It will be a late afternoon return back to your hotel with the remainder of your day at leisure.

### Day 3

After breakfast, join your guide for a trip to the charming medieval town of Saint-Émilion. Explore the best of this UNESCO-listed village, including a wine tasting at a grand cru wine estate, a walk along the historic city walls, and visits to unique artist galleries and studios. After, head to Rue Sainte-Catherine, Bordeaux's main shopping street. Narrow and lined with majestic four-story townhouses, *La Rue* stretches almost one mile—it's a great place to shop, people watch, and observe the locals in their daily routine. After, you'll be taken back to the hotel. Either relax or explore further before this evening's activity—dinner at the local Château.

### Day 4

This morning, after breakfast, you'll be taken to the airport for your onward flight.
